




Caregivers Empowering Each Other (CEO) Program

This year, Latin is partnering with the Medstar Georgetown WISE Center, to further enhance the already thriving Mental Health program at Latin. WISE partners with schools to deliver the following services:



CEOs is a network that engages and connects caregivers and is hosted by the MedStar WISE Center. Weekly group meetings include a WISE consultant and 3-4 other caregivers. Here, caregivers share their stories, receive consultation for their families, and teach, learn from, and support one another.

At Washington Latin, we will adapt this curriculum to be a monthly open session to all parents who wish to come and learn and connect on specific topics and issues that pertain to the health and wellness of their children and themselves.
