- Advisory starts each day - “home base” for the year
- Students switch classes - not with same cohort all day
- 5th grade: Math, English, Science, Geography, Latin, Theater, PE
- All students in Middle School have Academic Support - structured study hall or additional instruction, as needed
- Lunch + recess (30 minutes each)
- Tutorial - 3:15 - 3:45 M-Th “office hours” for every teacher to provide additional support.

Student Support Services (Special Education)

- A case manager in every grade, a school psychologist (for evaluations), and a 504 coordinator
- Works closely with our Mental Health Department (including 6 counselors) and Integrated Services Department (includes 2 social workers) to ensure students can fully access our program and thrive at Latin.
- ***As part of enrollment process, you send us your child's IEP or 504 plan.***
- We will meet over the summer with families whose children come to Latin with IEP or 504 plan in place.



Extra curriculars

- ***MAGIS afterschool program*** - Offered to 5-7th on M-Th, dismissal to 6:00 pm; fee-based program with reduced rates for FARMs-eligible students
- ***Sports*** begin in 6th grade (plus Girls on the Run for 5/6)
 - *Fall*: Soccer, Cross Country, Volleyball, Flag Football
 - *Winter*: Basketball, Indoor Track, Wrestling
 - *Spring*: Baseball, Softball, Lacrosse, Track, Tennis, Ultimate Frisbee
 - Each season, we offer fitness classes (yoga, martial arts, more!)
- ***Clubs*** - Students grades 5-12 can start a club on any topic (with faculty advisor) and meet during lunch. ***More than 40 today!***
- ***Theater & Music*** - Theater and Music are required classes, but we also have a robust extracurricular program - fall play and spring musical, and several musical groups (Honors Choir, Jazz Band) that perform at and outside of school.



School Uniform

- ***School uniform is required!***
 - Blue, white or gray polo shirt
 - Khaki or navy bottoms
 - Shoes - closed toe
 - Sweaters, fleeces or sweatshirts with logo or printed LATIN (worn over polo)
- ***PE uniform*** also required for 5th and 6th
 - Latin gray shirt and mesh shorts;
sweatshirt/pants optional
- ***Purchase*** new from G-Land (local!) or Lands End, or gently used from Latin parent sales at back-to-school events!





Latin Bus Services

- Fee-based service, *free* for those qualifying for Free & Reduced Meals
- Service in morning & afternoon (3:45 departure), late (4:45 departure)
- Current stops in Capitol Hill, Tenley Town, Anacostia
- Can be part- or full-time and vary by season or full-year

- Deadline is ***May 1!***
- Please complete the ***enrollment form*** and ***residency verification*** to hold your child's seat (other items can come later).
- ***Need help?*** Visit our campus on **Sat. 4/29, 9:00-12:00** (and also take a tour of our campus!)
- ***Other forms*** health, dental, special needs (IEP and 504, English Language Learner status and assessments, etc.) and records (especially for rising 9th graders!) → **sooner is better!**
- ***Once enrollment is complete***, we will reach out with other opportunities to come to campus (students and families) to connect, ask questions, etc.

- 6/26 - 7/12 - Session 1; 7/13 - 7/28 - Session 2
- Open to all Latin students - *including new students!*
- Academic strengthening in Math and English for 5th
- Grades 5-8 - 8:45-1:30 + MAGIS (afternoon enrichment) to 4:30
- Grades 9-12 from 8:15-1:30

- **9th Grade Summer Bridge**
 - Special program designed for new-to-Latin 9th graders
 - Begin to get to know our program and expectations
 - Perhaps even more important, start building community with faculty and students before school starts
