

Credit Requirements, Sports, Community Service

- 4 credits English
- 4 credits Math
 (one year past Algebra II)
- 4 credits Science
- 4 credits History
 (including D.C. History and Government)
- 3 credits Latin (through Latin III)
- 2 credits Chinese, Spanish or Arabic (through the second level)
- 3.5 credits Electives
 (credits that are above and beyond the minimum and specifically named graduation requirements and are of the student's choosing)

- 0.5 credit Art
- 0.5 credit Health
- 0.5 credit Music
- 0.25 credit Financial Literacy
- 1 credit Athletics (four seasons)
- 100 hours Community Service

Students need at least 27.25 credits to graduate!

Math Curriculum - Overview

• Washington Latin uses the *Common Core standards* to sequence all math courses from 5th grade through Algebra 2.

• Every student has the opportunity to take credit-bearing *Algebra 1 by 8th grade* and Calculus by 12th grade.

• We offer *intensive Math support* for students who demonstrate a need through diagnostic testing.


