DC CAPE and AP Testing



What is DC CAPE?



- Annual test required for all public schools in DC
- Administered each spring in Math and English/Language Arts (ELA) in grades 5-10
- DC Science test also in spring for 5th and 11th
- A good test of our students' growth and achievement at both individual and school-level
- DC CAPE is also used in *rating schools*, including Latin

An ask for families



All students take DC CAPE and MAP tests online, using school Chromebooks!

- Make sure your child brings their Chromebook on test days!
- Check that they charge them every night!



Implications for Middle School



- Students will arrive and dismiss as usual.
- After testing, classes will meet on a modified schedule.
- Wednesday classes will dismiss at 2:40 pm (normally the end of our tutorial period)
- Some important field trips during this window, i.e. Echo Hill for 7th Graders!

Implications for US

Delayed start on some days to allow for other grades' morning testing to proceed uninterrupted.

- Grades 9 & 10 arrive at <u>10:30</u> Wed 5/1, Thurs 5/2.
- Grades 11 & 12 arrive at 1:00 pm on the following dates:
 - Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday 4/24 4/26
 - Tuesday and Wednesday 5/1 and 5/2
 - REGULAR arrival time all other days!
- On testing days, classes will meet on a **modified schedule**. (Students will receive detailed information.)
- There will be several opportunities for students to participate in AP Review sessions on late arrival days.

AP Testing

Latin offers Advanced Placement (AP) courses in the Upper School every year.

- All students in AP courses are studying at the college level and must take the national AP exam in May.
- National AP Testing will be administered for all students enrolled in AP courses May 6th and May 13th.
- AP Testing will happen off-site at the Harewood building; students <u>must</u> report to campus and take a school shuttle!
- Students are not expected to attend any classes on the day of their AP testing.
