

What is Advisory?

Advisory is a time for shared community amongst a subset of students and an adult. We believe that this space is one for information sharing, character building, and community engagement.

• Advisory meets from 8:10am - 8:20am each morning. We review the Daily Bulletin, check technology and uniform, and do a general wellness check.

What is Advisory Lunch?

- Each Wednesday we will have **advisory lunch** during our lunch block (sometimes this is adjusted based upon events of the week).
- This is a time for advisories to break bread together and further build community and relationships.
- Some advisory lunches will also consist of school wide initiatives (i.e. Panorama survey, scheduling).

What is Advisory Lunch Clean Up?

Advisories in grades 9-11 will participate in **lunch clean up** once per quarter. In line with serving the common good, we ask all community members to help keep our school clean!

Why is there a new Advisory grading system?

Advisory has always been a critical piece of supporting studentship and building community.

- In recent years, we have seen a decline in attendance and engagement in these spaces. This year, we are making changes!
- If you earn 64% or greater, you will PASS for the year and earn 0.25 elective credits.

^{*}To be considered "in uniform," a student must enter Advisory wearing their full uniform OR promptly get into uniform when asked

What if I am absent for the day or arrive at school late?

- Unexcused absence or tardy = 0 points
- Excused absence or tardy = Verified exemptions accounted for at grading deadlines
 - If a student is failing (<64%), we will go back and account for the excused absences.

How will students and families know about their Advisory grade?

- Advisors will enter in daily grades into DeansList (5 points per day) Weekly Reports, sent out on Mondays, will include the earned points for the previous week
- At both the interim and end of each quarter, grades (Pass or Fail), will be entered into PowerSchool.
