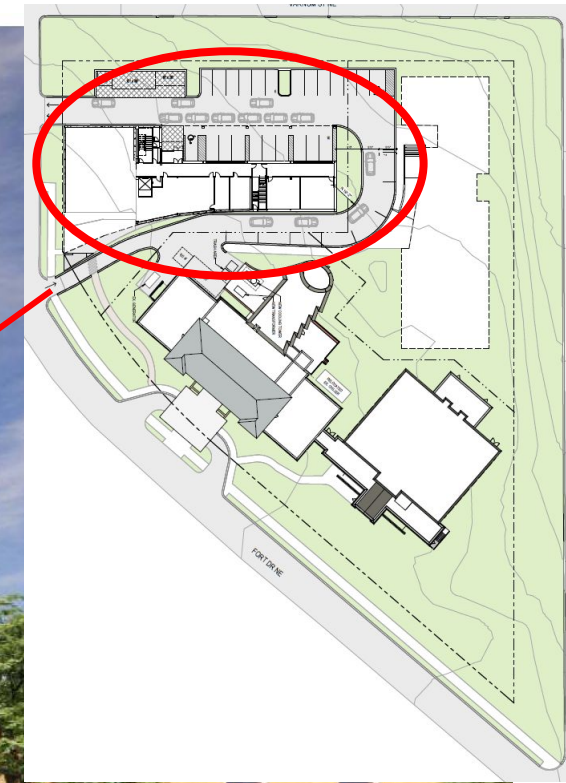

Cooper Campus - 4301 Harewood Road NE



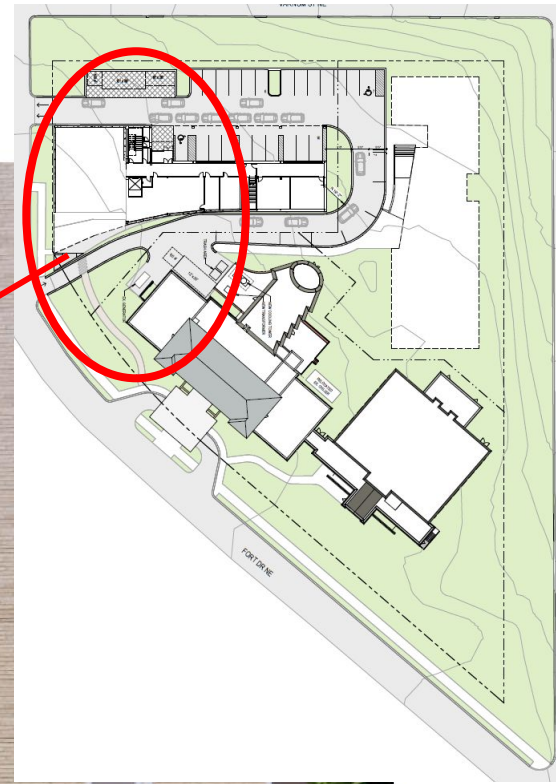

Getting there

Metro Bus - D74 metro bus (part of WMATA Better Bus proposal to be implemented in June) will have a stop on the corner of 2nd st. NE and Taylor st., 1 block from Cooper entrance!

Metro train - Brookland or Georgia Ave/Petworth (D74 bus from either); Fort Totten also fairly close (1 mile)

Latin bus service - This will continue at Harewood, with adjustments to stops possible to meet demand.

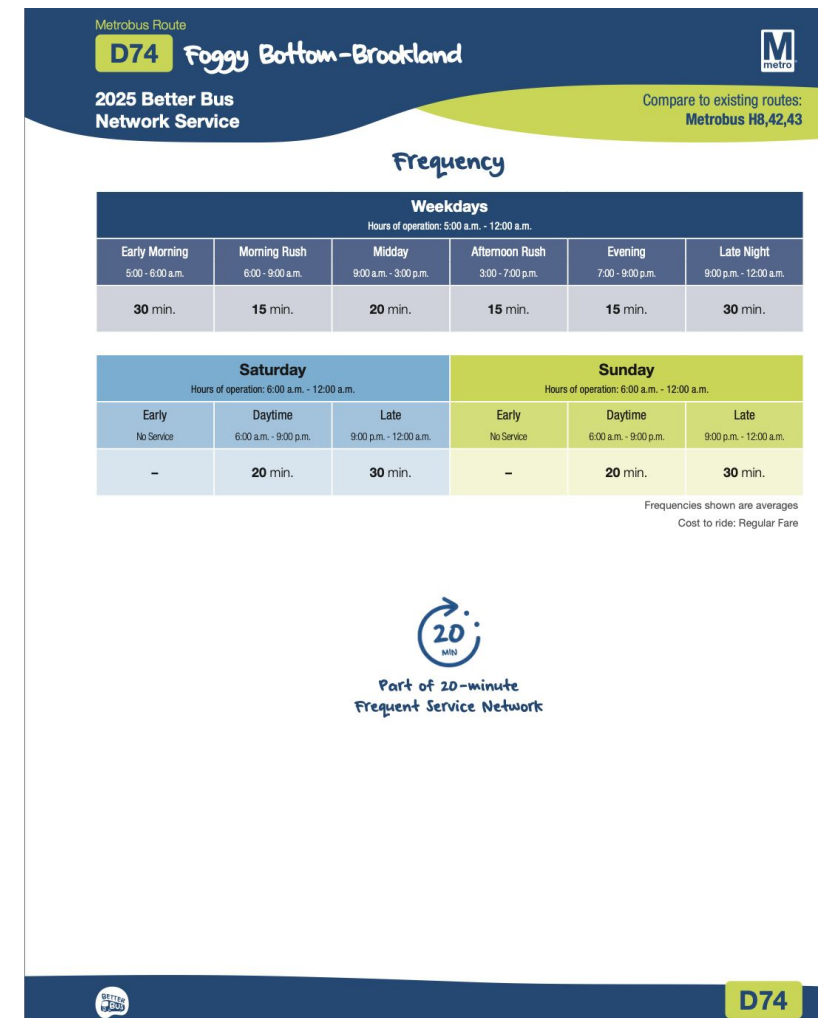
Pick up and Drop off (PUDO)

- Gate will be open to create a loop for cars AM and PM; closed during the day for safety
- The PUDO process is not final until the building is done; your grace and cooperation appreciated as we figure it out!

Campus Life - Moving about the buildings

- Students will have a home base in their respective building, but will have opportunities to travel between both buildings:
 - Library, gym, performance space in historic building
 - MPR/cafeteria, rooftop terrace, science labs in new building
- Outdoor spaces will be available for recess
 - Rooftop terrace and BB court, field space for soccer and other recess activities
 - Rooftop Garden - for learning and also to provide some food for lunch!
- Purposeful separation from Yu Ying students through specific landscaping/design elements that delineate each school's area



Athletics Program

On-campus athletics spaces

- Gym and weight room - lower level
- Rooftop basketball court - can be practice space, recess (but not games)
- Theater/dance space will be on first floor
- Field space - still in the works!

Athletics

- Latin will continue to have **a joint athletics program**, using the available spaces to house key components of our program (e.g. wrestling at Harewood; basketball at 2nd St).
- When we identify a field near Cooper, we will add that to the practice/game mix for Fall and Spring sports.
- The new buildings will give us many more opportunities to increase access to athletic programming and engagement
